Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Tribute Event?

The Tribute Event is to honour Dr. Eileen de Villa for her exemplary leadership as Medical Officer of Health for the City of Toronto during the pandemic. All proceeds from the event will fund our [Meals on Wheels](#) program.

Where and what time will the event take place?

At the Bernard Betel Centre – 1003 Steeles Avenue West, Toronto, M2R 3T6 from 7:00pm – 9:00 pm.

Is there parking at the Bernard Betel Centre?

The Bernard Betel Centre has a small, outdoor parking lot on the east side of the building. The driveway is located on the south side of Steeles Avenue, West. Parking is free of charge. The centre is easily accessible by [TTC](#) and [York Region Transit](#). Additional parking can be accessed in the FreshCo Plaza, located on the north side of Steeles Avenue West or in the Kiva's parking lot, east of the Bernard Betel Centre.

How much are tickets?

Tickets cost \$250 per person.

How can I purchase a ticket?

Will I receive a tax receipt with the purchase of a ticket?

Yes, you will receive a tax receipt for the allowable amount as specified by the CRA.

After I have purchased a ticket, will I receive a physical or digital ticket sent to me?

Yes, you will receive a digital or physical ticket sent to you after purchasing tickets. Your name will be on our guest list when you arrive. Tickets are transferrable.

Is there a dress code for the event?

Yes, business casual wear.
