What is the Tribute Event?

The Tribute Event is a fundraiser for the Bernard Betel Centre's [Meals on Wheels](#) program celebrating those who inspire. This year's event honours Dr. Anna Shternshis, Director of the Anne Tanenbaum Centre for Jewish Studies, Al and Malka Green Professor in Yiddish Studies; Fellow, John Guggenheim Memorial Foundation. All proceeds from the event will fund our Meals on Wheels program. This year we are delighted to have Elen Steinberg, Chair this critical event.

Where will the event take place?

At the Bernard Betel Centre – 1003 Steeles Avenue West, Toronto, M2R 3T6

What is the date and time of the event?

Wednesday, November 29, 2023 from 7:00pm – 9:00 pm.

Is there parking at the Bernard Betel Centre?

The Bernard Betel Centre has a small, outdoor parking lot on the east side of the building. The driveway is located on the south side of Steeles Avenue, West. Parking is free of charge. The centre is easily accessible by [TTC](#) and [York Region Transit](#). Additional parking can be accessed in the FreshCo Plaza, located on the north side of Steeles Avenue West or in the Kiva's parking lot, east of the Bernard Betel Centre.

How much are tickets?

Tickets are \$250 each.

No physical tickets will be given out. Your name will be added to our guest list which will be used as registration at the event. Please keep your receipt as proof of purchase.

Are tickets transferrable?

Yes, tickets are transferrable, but please email katiem@betelcentre.org if you are giving your ticket to someone else so we have their name on our guest list.

Is there a dress code for the event?

Yes, business casual wear.

What kind of event is it?

The Tribute Event will include a beautiful buffet with a variety of cold and hot food items, as well as delicious desserts. The event will include an open bar with beer and wine, and an array of hors d'oeuvres will be served by wait staff throughout the evening. There will be seating for those that prefer to sit at tables.

Who will be preparing the food?

All food will be prepared by the Bernard Betel Centre Chefs on-site at the Bernard Betel Centre in our kosher kitchen.

Can my dietary preference be accommodated?

All food at the event will be kosher prepared at the Bernard Betel Centre under the supervision of the Kashrut Council of Canada. Gluten-free, vegetarian, vegan, and Halal options will be available upon request when purchasing tickets.
